What is a P&F?

The St Maroun's P&F is a school based organisation consisting of parents, teachers and interested citizens.

The objectives are:

- Promote the interest of the College by bringing parents, citizens, students and teaching staff into close cooperation;
- Assist in providing facilities and equipment for the College and promoting the recreation and welfare of students at the College;
- Encourage parent and community participation in curriculum and other educational issues;
- Assist and cooperate with College staff at public functions associated with the College;
- Participate as much as possible in the activities of the College and communicate with all members of the school community.

Positions

P&F Executive committee consists of the:

- President;
- Vice President;
- Secretary; and
- Treasurer.

Any parent of the school may nominate themselves as a member of the P&F Committee.

By Friday 7th April 2017 nominations are open. A list of nominees will be announced and voting will commence. Voting will close on Wednesday 26th April 2017. The P & F Committee will be announced at a meeting to be held on Thursday 2nd May 2017.

At the next meeting, all the elected Members of the Executive shall retire from office, but shall be eligible for re-election or re-appointment.

Term of office of the elected Executive Members shall be one year with the right to serve a maximum of **3 years** consecutive full terms in the one position.

Having served the maximum term in one position the member may stand for election for another position on the Executive.

If an Executive member has served their maximum term and no nomination is forthcoming for that position, the voters may re-appoint the incumbent to that position.
